

Lace 1, 2, 3

Created exclusively for KnitPicks

Feather and Fan is one of my “comfort food” patterns. I know I can count on it to come through for just about anything I need or want to knit. Last minute baby afghans, legs of socks, cardigans, shawls, throws and scarves are just a few possibilities.

That’s why I chose it for a lace lesson. A simple repeat of 4 rows that is easily memorized. Only one row asks the knitter to pay attention.

Feather and Fan Pattern

This pattern has two extra stitches to form edges. The lace repeat is between the asterisks.

Row 1: (RS) Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K1, *[k2tog] 3 times, [yo, k1] 6 times, [k2tog] 3 times; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Note - Lace repeat is 18 stitches if you want to place markers.

Row 4: Knit

Rep Rows 1-4 until desired length. Bind off loosely.



Andean Treasure Shawl

Loosely CO 110 sts using size 6 needles.
Follow Feather and Fan pattern until desired length.



Loosely CO 164 sts using size 8 needles.
Follow Feather and Fan pattern until desired length.



Loosely CO 74 sts using size 3 needles.
Follow Feather and Fan pattern until desired length.

Lilac 23484, 8 balls.

Needles:

Size 6: 32" circular needle

Shadow Scarf

Suri Dream Throw

Finished Size:

Approximately 72" x 28"

Yarn:

Knit Picks *Suri Dream*

(74% Suri Alpaca, 22% Wool, 4% Nylon;

143 yds/50 gms):

Lilac 23674, 10 balls.

Needles:

Size 8: 40" circular needle

Shadow Scarf

Finished Size:

Approximately 78" x 7½"

Yarn:

Knit Picks *Shadow*

(100% Merino Wool;

440 yds/50 gms):

Grape Jelly 23662, 2 hanks.

Needles:

Size 3: 24" circular needle
